Why use cookies?

RapidTransfer places several cookies on your computer for the purpose of facilitating your use of the service and to find out how the service may be improved. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer by your browser when you visit a website. What types of cookies? For these purposes, RapidTransfer stores two kinds of cookies; function and analytical cookies. For facilitating your use of the service functional cookies are stored. • Type: OpenX, name: OX_u • Type: session, names: remember_user_token, _wt_session • Type: setting, names: wt_flash, wt_lang, wt_to, wt_from, wt_welcome, wt_ttype, wt_tandc, wt_sent To find out how the service may be improved, analytical cookies are stored. • Type: Google Analytics, names: HSID, SSID, APISID, SAPISID, PREF, NID, SID What information do these cookies collect? The cookies from RapidTransfer collect non-personal data in relation to the way the service is used within your browser. These cookies are not designed to track you as a person, or to follow your behavior on the internet. Can you remove or delete cookies? If you would want to remove certain cookies, or block them from being stored in your browser, it is possible to arrange this through your browser settings for cookies. You can find these settings under the Privacy tab in the Preferences section of most browsers. Here you can specify your cookie preferences or remove cookies.
